- Written by Luke
 - Acts of the Apostles (witnessing & power)
 - Times after Jesus death, burial & resurrection
 - Jesus appears to many for 40 days
 - Holy Spirit was given
 - 3 different outlines
 - Up (Jesus), Down (Holy Spirit), Out (Disciples)
 - Jerusalem (1-7), Judea / Samaria (8-12), Outer (13-28)
 - John (1-12), Paul (12-28)
- 2nd Acts 1:1-11 Introduction & ascension
- Jesus appears for 40 days (1-5)
 - V4 Wait for what Father promised
 - V5 Holy Spirit
 - Apostles question Jesus (6-8)
 - V7 Not for you to know
 - V8 You will receive power from Holy Spirit
 - Ascension (9-11)
 - V9 Jesus ascends into cloud
 - V10 2 angels
 - V11 Jesus will come back same way
- 3rd Acts 1:12-25 After Jesus Ascension
- Apostles return to Jerusalem (12-14)
 - V14 All one mind, prayed
 - Peter speaks to 120 people (15-25)
 - V16-20 Judas fulfilled scripture
 - V21-25 Replaced Judas with Matthias, prayed
- 4th Acts 2:1-13 Day of Pentecost
- Holy Spirit fills everyone (1-4)
 - V2 Wind from heaven
 - V4 Filled with Holy Spirit
 - Understand each other (5-13)
 - V6 Hearing each other in own language
 - V13 Some were mocking
